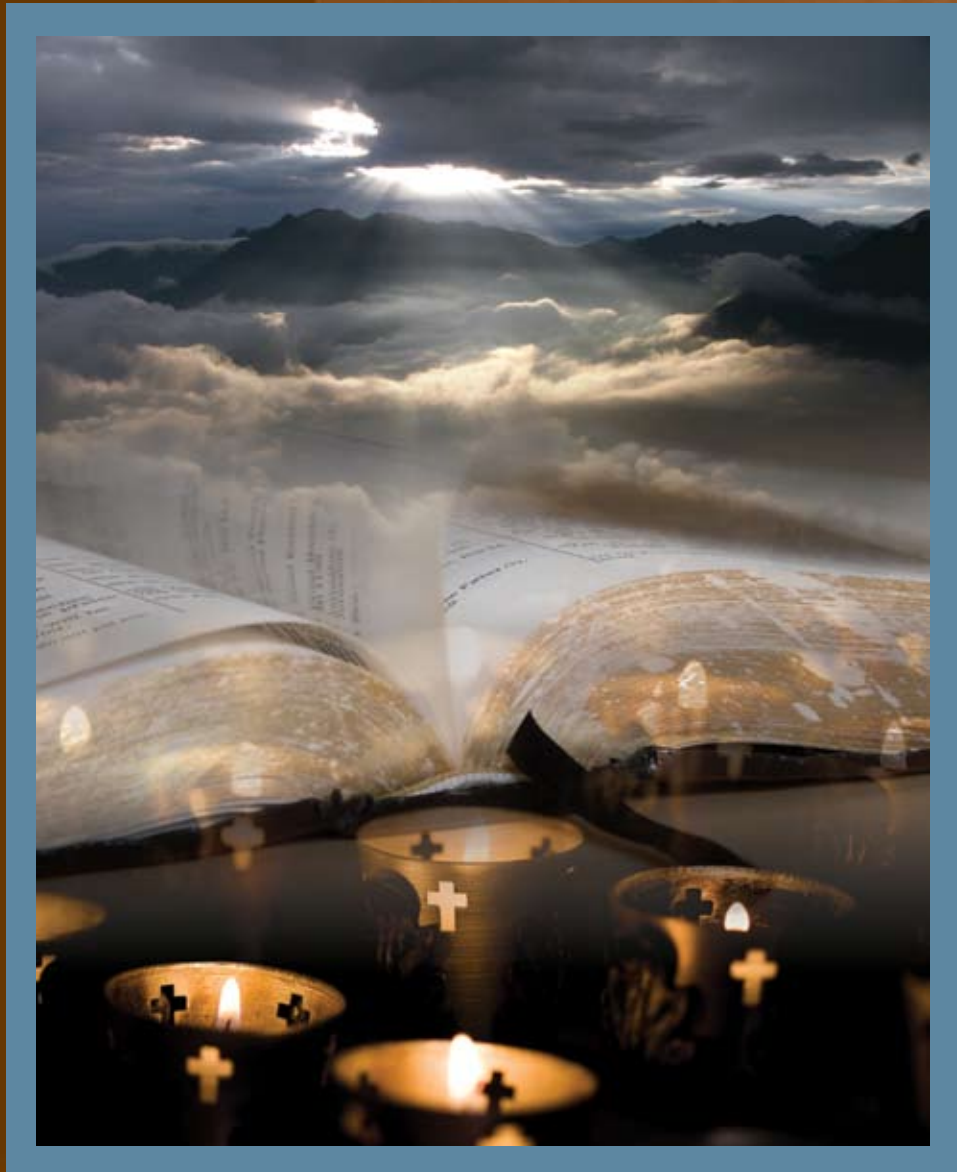

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

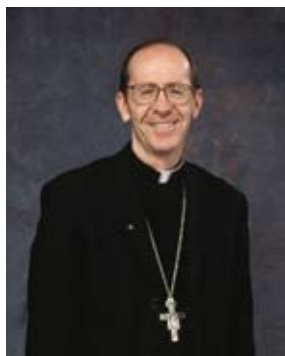

FOUNDATION PRESIDENT APPOINTED

Serving as facets of Christ’s light requires dedicated leadership. In 2007 the Catholic Community Foundation welcomed Donna Marino as President and CEO. A spirited advocate for the Foundation, she is committed to its long-term success. BOARD OF DIRECTORS LEAD BY EXAMPLE

In the last year, Board members opened their hearts and homes to measurably encourage committed Catholic philanthropy throughout the community. Board committees worked tirelessly to further the Foundation’s presence and profile, while the annual Board retreat inaugurated new members and developed initiatives for continued growth.



FOUNDATION AWARDS SET NEW RECORD

The result of astute investment and exceptional donor generosity, Foundation giving for the year exceeded previous levels by a record-setting \$1 million. Funding for various grants and scholarships was profoundly increased, as evidenced by the joyous Grants Reception in late 2007 when organizations received their awards.



20TH ANNIVERSARY OF PAPAL VISIT TO PHOENIX

To mark the two decades since the arrival of John Paul II in Phoenix, the Foundation’s Board of Directors presented a commemorative portrait of the late pontiff to Bishop Olmsted. Depicting life scenes and causes dear to John Paul II, the work now hangs in the Diocesan Pastoral Center alongside the collection of vestments and liturgical vessels used by His Holiness when he celebrated Mass before thousands in 1987.

It is with joy we reflect on the impact the Catholic Community Foundation has had in the Diocese of Phoenix during 2006 and 2007. Through the generosity of donors and wise financial investments, the Foundation set a new record for grants and scholarship awards totaling \$2.38 million, \$1 million more than in 2006! Every Foundation donor personifies Christian service; their reasons for giving are as varied as they are compelling. Their commitment embraces the community with far-reaching effects. Donna Killoughey Bird is no exception. As she says, "The Catholic Community Foundation is everything you want it to be when you're living out your Catholic values."

Her commitment took on added importance after September 11, 2001, when she lost her husband, Gary Bird, in the attacks on the World Trade Center Towers in New York. Steadfast in her faith, Donna realized that supporting Gary's favorite causes would be a fitting tribute to his loving spirit. Since then, when the Bird family was first profiled in the Foundation's 2002 Report, their generous support has only grown.

One focus of the Gary E. Bird Family Fund is Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School in Tempe, which both their children attended. The Gary E. Bird/Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School Scholarship fund commemorates Gary's own Christian service by recognizing exemplary student volunteerism. Initiated and funded by a visionary school board and augmented by Donna's contributions, it helps defray Catholic high school tuition costs. As she says, "The award is truly blessed by the Holy Spirit and captures the essence of my late husband. It is a joy to present at each eighth grade graduation."

Knowing Gary's legacy continues not just in the hearts of their own children, but also in the lives of many others is central to Donna's faithful stewardship. "Each time I give, I get back so much more," she reflects. "Recognizing that there are gifts from God even in the midst of crisis has been a blessing... I try to make all I do be an act of service, and the Catholic Community Foundation helps me do that."

The Foundation's premier fundraising event is the annual Crozier Gala. Against all odds, St. Louis the King Catholic School in Glendale, Arizona, proves this timeless truth every day. A tiny treasure of a Catholic community in the midst of an urban landscape, the inspired spirit and loving optimism shared by administration, staff and students is almost tangible.

It is this spirit of place that makes St. Louis the King such a compelling testament to the power of Catholic education. “We are like a family here,” Jane Daigle, school principal says. “Our teachers are committed to St. Louis the King and they are the reason we can do so much with so little.”

Doing a lot with a little underscores every aspect of life at St. Louis the King. With most of its 275 students receiving some level of tuition assistance, the school relies heavily on Catholic Community Foundation grants to help meet this urgent need. “CCF funds bridge the gap for families who receive tuition support but still struggle,” says Julie Schaffer, Director of Development. “We rely on CCF to ensure we don’t turn any child away.”

This commitment is demonstrated by a young sixth grader’s story; arriving at the school in the custody of her great grandmother ‘Carolina’ was so traumatized by life events that she barely spoke. Not knowing where to turn, her great grandmother hoped the school could help her. Assisted by CCF funds, it did. Today, she is a happy, well-adjusted high school student whose academic growth and self confidence are the result of the nurturing care she received at St. Louis the King. “We were here for this child,” states Principal Daigle, “And we’ll be here for any child who needs us—we’ll always find a way.”

Like St. Louis the King, every Diocesan school supported by CCF grants and scholarships finds a way every day to use the funds to make a difference in students’ lives. The faithful works of the Catholic Community Foundation are demonstrated by 2006-2007's landmark \$2.38 million in awards. This \$1 million increase in disbursements over the prior year reflects both Donor-Advised Fund distributions and the "annual competitive grants" process. The annual competitive grants process begins with local Catholic organizations submitting applications in the fall, followed by a thorough review and selection of finalists by the Foundation's volunteer Grants Committee. In the fall of 2006, 99 competitive grant applications were received, representing a total of \$1.1 million in requests for 2007 funding. The Grants Committee was able to award 73 grants totaling \$361,000 at the 2007 Grants reception, held in October at the Diocesan Pastoral Center.

25 YEARS OF SERVICE

Created to carry on the work of Christ by fostering philanthropy, the Catholic Community Foundation is poised to celebrate a milestone year in 2008—that of its 25th anniversary. Established by the Diocese of Phoenix in 1983 and led by its first president Bishop Thomas O’Brien, CCF has grown to become a significant source of support for various religious, education, communication and charitable agencies throughout the Diocese. Today, the Foundation has an endowment of \$52 million and reached a new milestone in 2007—increasing its giving by \$1 million for a total of \$2.38 million in grant and scholarship monies.



This could only have been made possible by the visionary commitment of the founding board members, donor generosity, the careful stewardship of financial gifts, and the faithful response to Christ’s commandment that we love each other as He loved us. (John 13:34).

20 YEARS OF SUPPORT

The Foundation’s premier fundraising event also celebrates an anniversary in 2008; the Crozier Gala marks its 20th year. Since the first event in 1989 that raised \$45,000 for the Foundation, to 2007’s total of over \$130,000, the Gala plays a pivotal role in the Foundation’s annual grant and scholarship programs.
